# Uniform

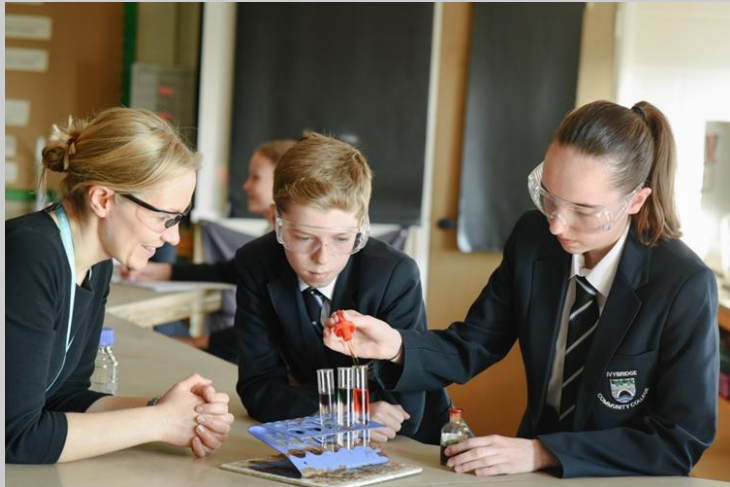
- Navy blue College blazer with College badge
- College tie to be worn at five stripes
- The Ivybridge Community College tartan skirt- no more than 4cm above the knee
- Grey, formal trousers, e.g. polyester mix; **not** cord, brushed denim, jeans, chinos
- White shirt **which buttons up to the neck**; short sleeves are acceptable in the Summer Term
- Navy blue knitted jumper with embroidered College badge (optional)
- Plain black, navy blue or white socks not over the knee or below the ankle (no logos or sports socks), or black tights
- Sensible, black, formal, flat shoes (leather or patent shoes that can be polished only and **not** leather trainers e.g. Converse/Vans) – no boots, canvas shoes, trainers.
- No branded items with logos; these include clothing (e.g. hoodies), footwear or accessories such as belts

## **Jewellery:**

A watch, plain silver/gold stud earrings – one in the lower lobe of each ear. No other jewellery is permitted in the interest of safety.

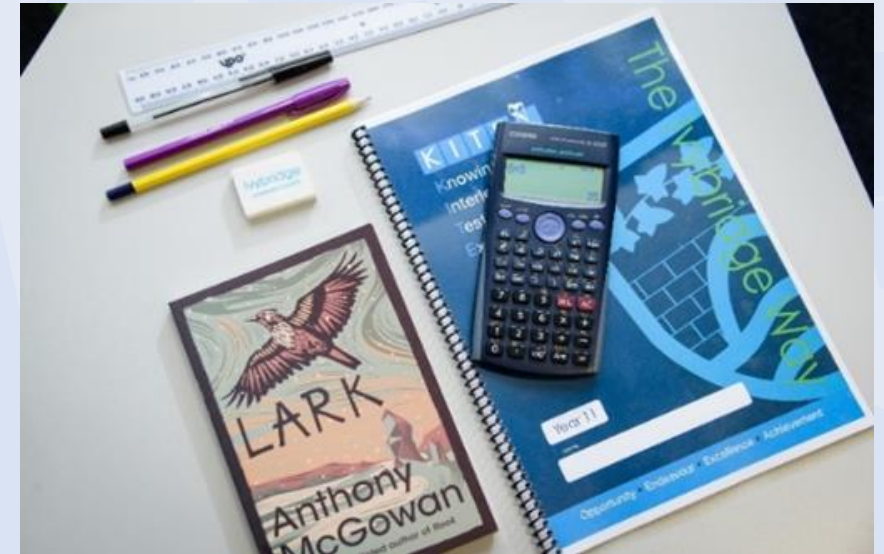
- **Grey formal shorts** have been a recent addition to the College uniform this term.

# Mentors




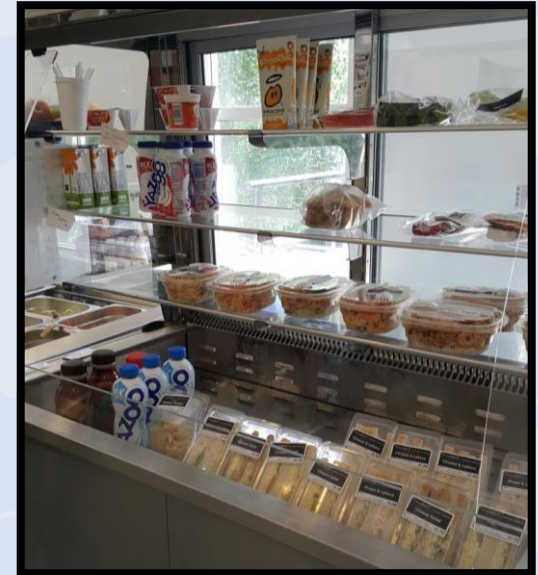
- Provide the Year 7s with information and guidance about the College.

# Year 6 Induction Day Thursday, 4 July 2024
